Sanitizing your Mattress for Service

What is involved with sanitizing a mattress?

There are various methods of sanitizing a mattress, these generally involve:

- Extraction: Physically pulsating and penetrating extracting away accumulated contaminants.
- Ultraviolet Sterilization: This deactivates the DNA of biological stains and marks
- Antibacterial Treatment: This sanitizing process both cleans and protects.
- Anit-Allergen Treatment: Extraction of dust mites, foreign cells that cause allergic reactions.

Why is this necessary?

It is a requirement that all mattresses be sanitized before they are brought back to our facility for service. This is for the protection of our employees as they will be working with and handling your mattress.

What are the health implications of an untreated mattress?

An un-sanitized mattress may expose the sleeper and our employees to unnecessary health risks. Sanitizing a mattress helps to remove dead skin, dust mites, dust mite excrement and other dry particles and sediments. Regardless of your pending mattress service it is recommended to sanitize your mattress regularly to avoid these potential asthma and allergy triggers.
